## Graduation Attire:

Ladies are to wear a **white** formal floor length dress. There needs to be at least a one-inch shoulder strap. Be certain that the dress is **white**. *Off white or ivory dresses are not permitted.* Two-piece "dresses" are also not permitted. To insure we do not have any problems (not white, low cleavage, too short, no shoulder strap, etc.), all ladies **MUST** bring their dress to school for visual approval by Ms. Carroll. Also, ladies should not wear sneakers, flip-flops or boots – shoes should be of a solid, neutral color. Ladies should be aware of the fact that a slip should be worn with their dress. Ladies dressed inappropriately for graduation will **NOT** participate in the Graduation Program.

Gentlemen are to wear a *formal tuxedo*. Specifically: white dinner jacket, black pants, black cummerbund, black bow tie and black only shoes (no sneakers, flip-flops or boots). Vests are **NOT** to be worn. The tuxedo can be rented from any establishment. Also, graduates must be clean shaven. Gentlemen dressed inappropriately for graduation will **NOT** participate in the Graduation Program.

## **SENIOR PARENTS**

Seniors will be completing a post graduation form notifying the guidance department of their final college decision. If your senior has not made a final decision (or changes his/her mind), please notify the guidance office as soon as possible so the final transcript is sent to the correct college. ALL transcripts (including NCAA) and immunization reports will be mailed by Thursday, July 6, 2017.

## **JUNIOR PARENTS - SAT and ACT**

**\* We recommend that all juniors take the SAT or ACT exam at least one time.**

If your student wishes to take/retake the **SAT** on June 3, 2017, at an area high school, the registration deadline is May 9, 2017. The late registration deadline is May 24, 2017. Students can register at [www.sat.collegeboard.org](http://www.sat.collegeboard.org).

If your student wishes to take the **ACT** on June 10, 2017, at an area high school, the registration deadline is May 5, 2017. Students can register at [www.actstudent.org](http://www.actstudent.org).

Applications are available in the guidance office for the Rensselaer County Summer Youth Employment Program for economically disadvantaged youth. Student must be 14-19 years of age.


